It adjoins Wotton Common on the same side of Leith Hill and includes Abinger Hammer, Sutton Abinger, Abinger Common, Forest Green, Walliswood, Oakwood Hill and some outskirts of Holmbury St Mary.

U-shaped plan around quadrangle with arms splayed apart, the original common room connecting across the arms North-South, western ends of the arms built in 1910.

Goddards was built by Edwin Lutyens for Frederick Mirrielees in 1898-1900. Designed in his Surrey traditional style, it shows his mastery of local materials - stone, brick, roughcast and oak - and it is considered one of his most important early houses.

**Abinger Common - Goddards**

The influence of his friend and collaborator, Gertrude Jekyll and her enthusiasm for the local vernacular architecture, can also be strongly felt at Goddards, where she planted the courtyard garden. The site was a plot of seven acres near Pasture Wood, Abinger Common, where the Mirrielees family were living.
