Tanzania has a five-level judiciary system combining the jurisdictions of tribal, Islamic, and British common law. Judges are appointed by the Chief Justice in all courts, except the Court of Appeals and the High Court where they are appointed by the president. Advocates defend clients in all courts, other than primary courts.
